SIMMENTAL RULES & REGULATIONS

WHEN & WHERE:

- CHECK-IN TIME** – Noon-5 p.m. on Tuesday, January 21 at the W.H. Lyon Fairgrounds Expo Building, Sioux Falls, SD.
- SHOW TIME** – Wednesday, January 22, 2020 at the W. H. Lyon Fairgrounds Expo Building – 100 N. Lyon Blvd., Sioux Falls, SD 57107. Simmental Show will begin at 10 a.m.
- SALE TIME** – Simmental Sale will start at approximately 4 p.m., after the Red Angus Sale

ENTRY:

Limit of 2 bulls and 2 heifers per consignor with a maximum of 25 bulls accepted in the breed. Please number your entries for preference. All entries can be rejected at any time.

FEES –

\$110 for bulls & \$85 for females per head; payable to Sioux Empire Livestock Show, 200 N. Phillips Ave., Suite 200, Sioux Falls, SD 57104. Entry fees must accompany the entry and be made payable to the Sioux Empire Livestock Show. No refunds, however, substitutions may be made.

- **FITTING CHUTES:** One fitting chute will be allowed per three animals at a fee of \$30 per chute with the second chute allowed in with the fourth head at an additional cost of \$30. Upon check-in, tags will be issued and must be attached to the fitting chute.
- The first layer of wood chip bedding will be provided, however, if you desire more than what is provided, you can purchase from the Barn Superintendent in the blue information shack or bring your own. Ten (10) dollars will be withheld from each consignor Auction Check; this is a standard bedding fee.
- A \$1 fee will be deducted for the Beef Check Off.

DEADLINE –

All entries must be submitted online or postmarked by November 10, 2019. You must include the following: copy of certificate of registry, footnotes, and bull service in case of females. Entries not postmarked by November 10 will not be accepted.

- **ONLINE ENTRY INFORMATION:** Online entry deadline is also November 10, 2019. Go to www.siouxempirelivestockshow.com to register online! If you have any questions, feel free to contact Holly Rader, Show Manager, at (605) 373-2016, or hrader@siouxfalls.com.

MEMBERSHIP: All consignors must be members of the South Dakota Simmental Association. The fee is \$35 per member, which must be paid at entry time. If you are not a member, make a check payable to the SD Simmental Association and enclose it with your entry fee for the Sioux Empire Livestock Show. The SD Simmental Association check will be forwarded.

SALE COMMISSION: A commission of 8% on the final claiming bid, over and above the entry fee, will be charged on each consignment, which will go to the SD Simmental Association to cover sale costs and promotion. No Sales

will pay 8% of the last bid accepted. NO SALES WILL PAY THE SALE COMMISSION ON THE LAST BID ACCEPTED. No refunds.

In case of a NO SALE situation, ABSENTEE BUYER or successful PHONE BUYER the consignor MUST BE PREPARED to make complete and full settlement immediately following the sale to the cashier clerking the sale. Time is of the essence as our clerks and cashiers are volunteers from the area and books need to be balanced after the sale. All sold cattle must have the paid drive-out slip (pink slip) before departure of the building.

REGISTRATION PAPERS: Only 1/2 or better cattle with Registration Certificates for each animal will be accepted. A copy of the registration paper should accompany entry form and must be in the Farm Show office prior to check-in. All entries must be clean of genetic defects by the ASA. Any animal without a proper Registration Certificate will not be allowed to enter the show or sale ring, NO EXCEPTIONS! All registration papers will be collected and transferred by the Simmental Committee; ALL ANIMALS MUST BE CONSIGNED BY ORIGINAL OWNER AND BREEDER. The consignor will be responsible for transferring registration papers and paying any expenses to the purchaser incurred.

When monitoring genetic abnormalities, only Pedigree Free, Documented Free and Assumed Free entries will be accepted. All population risk and carrier in lineage animals must be tested and updated at the ASA by check-in time.

PEDIGREES: A copy of the pedigree for each animal consigned must be sent with the entry form. The Simmental Show Committee will screen pedigrees. You must bring original pedigree to the Show. The pedigree will be checked in by the Simmental Committee and no cattle will be allowed through the sale ring without original documentation.

AGE: Bulls must be born after December 31, 2017 and before April 1, 2019. Heifers must be born after December 31, 2017 and calved no later than May 15, 2018. No Fall 2017 calves accepted.

QUALITY: A screening committee will be checking cattle during the Show for soundness and quality. Any cattle sifted will be asked to leave the building prior to the sale, with no refund of entry fees. We ask you to bring your best, so we can have one of the top sales in the area.

Heifer calves entered and shown will be eligible to show at the Junior Field Days Heifer Futurity.

SUPREME ROW: The 2020 Sioux Empire Livestock Show's \$12,000 Supreme Row is brought to you by our generous sponsors: Tri-State Neighbor (gold sponsor), Wells Fargo Bank (silver sponsor), and Campbell's (bronze sponsor). See enclosed rules.

All 2020 Sioux Empire Livestock Show entries will also be published in a catalog. The catalog is distributed through the Tri-State Neighbor, merging their entire livestock producer mailing list with the SELS mailing list. Prospective buyers are reached with this distribution method, but you are encouraged to do your homework and invite buyers, as well. The catalog will also be published on the Sioux Empire Livestock Show website and be available to all visitors of the 2020 Show.

AD SPACE IN SELS CATALOG: All 2020 SELS consignors also have the opportunity to purchase advertising space in our 2020 Purebred Cattle Guide (catalog). All 2020 SELS purebred cattle entries will be published in this catalog. The catalog is distributed through the Tri-State Neighbor, merging their entire livestock producer mailing list with the SELS mailing list, reaching over 10,000 regional producers/potential buyers. For ad specifics/dimensions, contact Holly Rader at hrader@siouxfalls.com, or (605) 373-2016. The minimum space and fee allowed will be 3.5" wide X 3" tall; Black & White; Fee: \$100. Your ad must be sent to hrader@siouxfalls.com by November 10, 2019. Only production ready ad copies will be accepted. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE EXPO BUILDING!

BULLS ONE YEAR OF AGE AND OLDER MUST HAVE NOSE RING.

SHOW WILL BE NO FIT. NO ADHESIVES ALLOWED.

Terms of each breed sale are cash or check with settlement to be made with the Sale Clerk at time of sale. Consignors and/or buyers' representative should be prepared to pay the total price in absence of the buyer.

After an animal is sold, it will be led from the sale ring to the tie stall. Sold animals may not be removed from the building until the pink slip is presented to Barn Superintendent in the blue information shack. Arrangements may be made to house the animal overnight, but care for that animal is solely the responsibility of the consignor or buyer.

Each consignor accepts the responsibility of guaranteeing breeding soundness of each animal consigned. The Sioux Empire Livestock Show acts only as an agent and does not assume any responsibility for the health and breeding soundness of the animal. All guarantees are strictly between buyer and seller. The buyer assumes all risk on animals as soon as they are declared sold.

The Sioux Empire Livestock Show, the Sioux Falls Area Chamber of Commerce, the W.H. Lyon Fairgrounds, and anyone associated with helping with the Show assumes no responsibility for accident of injury and will not be responsible for any injury, loss of any animal, or accident thereby.

ALL LIVESTOCK CONSIGNORS ARE RESPONSIBLE, AT ALL TIMES, FOR THEIR ANIMALS AND THEIR WELFARE (i.e.: if one gets loose, etc.).

CATTLE HEALTH REGULATIONS: A current, completed Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI), listing individual animal official identification (official ear tag or registration tattoo accompanied by the registration certificate) must accompany all animals exhibited. The CVI must be issued within 30 days of entry. CVIs written for animals originating from outside the State of South Dakota must have a telephone import permit number listed on the certificate. Import Permits are issued to the veterinarian completing the CVI and can be obtained by calling (605) 773-3321. Cattle originating from outside of the state may be subject to more requirements. Animal health import requirements can be found at <http://aib.sd.gov/mainimport.html> or call the SD Animal Industry Board at (605) 773-3321.

TRICHOMONIASIS: All non-virgin bulls must be tested negative within 30 days of the sale date. Approved testing methods include:

- One negative PCR test conducted on a preputial scraping sample.
- Three consecutive negative culture attempts of preputial scraping samples collected with a minimum of seven days between each collection.

The veterinarian issuing the CVI must certify that the bull has not bred since the start of the test and a copy of the test results must be attached to the CVI. Virgin bulls are exempt from testing. **MAKE SURE IT IS STATED ON THE CERTIFICATE IF YOUR BULL(S) IS/ARE VIRGIN.**

Cattle must be free of any infectious, contagious, or communicable disease at the time of entry onto the Fairgrounds. If warts have been surgically removed, the scars must be healed by the time of exhibition.

Semen check is required on all bulls 15 months of age, or older, as breed requires. We must have the DATES OF TESTS AND WHERE THEY WERE TESTED; (Name of lab and address) listed on CVI.

ALL INFORMATION MUST BE RECORDED ON THE CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION TO ACCOMPANY THE ANIMALS ENTERED.

When you get your catalog, put your lot number on the top right-hand side of the CVI. Give the CVI to the barn attendant in blue information shack in the northeast corner of the stalling barn prior to unloading.

Any question regarding the health of an animal will be based on the animal's condition as it is presented on entry day. This determination is at the discretion of the Show veterinarian and official show representative.

1. Animals must be owned by consignor and registered in same name 6 months prior to entry date.
 - a. Exception for registration only: The dam of animals born in 2018 must be registered in consignor's name six months prior to entry date. (Breed representatives may require entries to be first owner.)
2. Minimum of 50% interest and full possession of animal must sell.
3. Grand Champion Bull and Grand Champion Female from each qualifying breed must be displayed on Supreme Row from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 23. The animal's care will be the consignor's responsibility.
4. Judging format will be announced at the Sioux Empire Livestock Show.
 - a. **The Supreme Row Social will be held immediately after the Supreme Row Judging on Thursday, January 23.** The Supreme Row Social is a great opportunity to visit after the cattle sales and enjoy some beverages with other producers from the region.
 - b. All Supreme Row exhibitors will be entered into the drawing for a 1-year lease on a 24' M.H. EBY, Inc. livestock trailer provided by M.H. EBY, Inc. Drawing of the trailer will take place at the conclusion of Supreme Row Judging by an M.H. EBY, Inc. representative.
 - c. The Supreme Bull and Supreme Female will be selected at 7 p.m. on Thursday, January 23, however the presentation of the Supreme Champions will be made at the Sale of Champions on the evening of Friday, January 24, which takes place at the Ramkota Exhibit Hall.
5. All registration certificates of animals sold will be transferred to a bonafide new owner, who is independent of the consignor. The Sioux Empire Livestock Show will check with breed associations, or other sources before sending award money and reserves the right to check in the future to verify bonafide sales of Supreme Champions.
6. The Sioux Empire Livestock Show Supreme Row Committee reserves the right to determine if rules have been violated and impose penalties on all individuals and firms involved. Penalties may include withholding, or reimbursement of all awards and being banned from future Sioux Empire Livestock Shows.
7. Any deviations or changes to these rules will be the discretion of the Sioux Empire Livestock Show; consignors and buyers will be informed in appropriate and timely manner. Decisions of the Sioux Empire Livestock Show are final.
